

DIRECTIONS TO THE ROCK-A-BAYOU RANCH

From Interstate 20 turn south at Exit 330, which is on the western edge of Cisco, on to Highway 206 towards Coleman.

Go approximately 20 miles to Cross Plains. As you go through Cross Plains, you will come to a four way stop and will see the local DQ on your left. (From Abilene, take Hwy 36 to the same four way stop in Cross Plains and turn right.)

Continue south through the four way stop for about a mile. Then bear left at the Y in the road and you will be on Highway 279 headed towards Brownwood.

Continue on Highway 279 for about 9 more miles and you will come to Brown County Road # 114, a gravel road to the right or West. You will also see a green Texas highway sign pointing to the "Smith Cemetery" just before you turn. (From Brownwood, take Hwy 279 north and, from the Lake Brownwood bridge, go almost exactly 10 miles and turn left on CR 114.)

Go through the cattle guard and continue West for 2.6 miles to a black mailbox on the left with the name of "Phillips". Turn left onto a small and rough ranch road and follow it, through two cattle guards, until you come to an open field where the road forms a T. Turn to the left (clearly the road with the most activity) and wind on around until you get to a yellow gate. Go through the yellow gate and then down the hill through the Pecan Bayou (a muddy creek). You will then come to a Y in the road and bear to the right. Just past the small barn, you will see the gate to the Rock-A-Bayou. Go through the gate and up the hill to the house.

Don't give up. It is 1.6 miles from the mailbox until you reach the house. Keep coming!
